


DELEGATION RECEPTION AND AIRPORT- HOTEL TRANSFERS JORGE NEWBERY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

ARRIVAL AT OFFICIAL HOTELS AND CHECK-IN

- Countries arriving before 6 PM on Monday, March 17, will check in at the hotel's front desk.

ACCREDITATION PROCESS

OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION CARDS WILL BE DISPATCHED ON MONDAY, 3/17, STARTING AT 6 PM.

The drop-off location within the hotel will be posted on the information board in the hotel lobby specifically for event information..

For this purpose, the passports of all delegation members must be presented.

The official ID card will be the document that allows transit, entry, and permanence in each official event facility: hotel, dining halls, shooting range, official transportation, etc.

It is essential to always carry this ID card in a visible manner, as it will be required on various occasions. If you are unable to show it, it may result in denial of entry to restricted areas. This ID card is personal and non-transferable.

- An official event information desk can be found in the lobby of the CYAN Hotel, just across from the elevators. Our volunteer team will be able to assist you with any questions you may have.



- There will be an information board next to the desk, where daily updates will be posted. Please pay attention to this each day.
